

BIOGRAPHY OF PASTOR AND MRS. FRANK HUGHES, JR.

Frank Hughes, Jr., was born in Currituck County, North Carolina, the second of four children of Frank and Aleada Doxey Hughes and was reared in Princess Anne County (now Virginia Beach). He was educated at Wake Forest College and Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas. In August, 1942, he was ordained to the Gospel Ministry by Kempsville Baptist Church.

Katharine Anne Read was born in Little Rock, Arkansas, the first of five children of John Leighton and Katharine Wauchope Read. At the age of two she moved to Western Oklahoma where her father (a Presbyterian Minister) served as a Missionary to the "Blanket" Indians. She was educated at Oklahoma University in Norman, Oklahoma and Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas, where she received a degree in Religious Education.

Frank Hughes, Jr. met Katharine Anne Read while both were attending Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary. They were married in September, 1942. They have three sons; Frank III (deceased), James Read (deceased), and Joseph Truett (now serving as Pastor of DeBaun Baptist Church).
