INTRODUCTION

1. As over 90 per cent of all Japanese definitely associated with war crimes reported in this area have now been traced, and exhaustive enquiries have failed to locate the remainder here, it is considered that investigations here are virtually closed.

2. Relief of AMF here is expected in a short time, when control of the area will pass to ALFSEA.

This report has therefore been compiled with the following objects :-

- (a) To give a brief survey of war crimes in this area.
- (b) To indicate methods used and results obtained in tracing war criminals.
- (c) To give the relieving Force an accurate idea of the present situation.
- (d) To assist officers preparing cases in Category C for trial. (Appendix A and B)
- (e) To furnish a consolidated list of war criminals (Appendix B) which incorporates all names previously listed by this HQ and furnishes the information required by paragraphs 8, 16 and 17, of HQ AMF 151625 of 26 Nov. 45.

FINAL REPORT ON WAR CRIMES INVESTIGATIONS

(NORTH BORNEO AREA)
SR 7754

1. The area covered included SARAWAK, BRUNEI, JAW and BRITISH NORTH BORNEO.

Reports were received of incidents outside this area namely:-

- (a) at LONGNAWAN
- (b) in the PONTIANAK area.

All evidence in these two cases is forwarded to HQ MOROTAI FORCE herewith.

2. Sources of information were as follows:-

- (a) Questionnaires and statements completed by ex PW and internees.
- (b) Several ex PW and internees who assisted with full statements and physical identification of criminals before repatriation. The assistance rendered by Maj N S McARTHUR 2/15 Punjabi Regt, Lt S T SUNDERLAND RASC and WO I STICPEWICH AASC 8 Aust Div has been invaluable.
- (c) Evidence of Chinese and native victims and witnesses.
- (d) Interrogation of Japanese.

With regard to (a) difficulty was experienced because:-

- (a) PW and internees were repatriated extremely quickly and only a relatively small number could be questioned here.
- (b) Completed questionnaires were forwarded by PW Contact and Enquiry Teams through their own channels and War Crimes personnel had to make extra copies. To gain the maximum information in the time available interrogating officers were appointed to cooperate with the Contact Teams and to specialise on important War Crimes Questionnaires.
- (c) Originals of questionnaires were not recovered from the War Crimes Commission and of some questionnaires not even copies were received.

With regard to (d) this was found to be a fruitful source of information and without the evidence thereby obtained, most of the charges could never have been proved. About 1,000 Japanese were interrogated in all.

3. War crimes committed by Japanese (including Formosans) in this area may be summarised as follows:-

(a) Against PW

(i) Deliberate mass murder by starvation

withholding medical supplies even those received from the American Red Cross.

overwork

Brutal and inhuman punishments for trivial and imaginary offences, and frequent unprovoked assaults of a savage nature.

(ii) Summary executions on the slightest pretext.

(iii) Massacres to prevent PW being released as in:-

SANDAKAN - RANAU marches

massacre at RANAU Aug 45

massacre of Indian PW at KUALA BELAIT Jun 45

massacre of PW at RIAM ROAD, MIRI in Jun 45

there is evidence that a similar death march to SANDAKAN - RANAU marches was planned for the male PW and internees at KUCHING. It was not carried into effect owing to the intervening surrender.

(iv) Employment of PW on unauthorised work, i.e., on military aerodromes at KUCHING, SANDAKAN and LABUAN, both for construction, maintenance and handling bombs and petrol.

(v) Transportation of PW under improper conditions. Every sea voyage made by PW was on overcrowded vessels, with bad and insufficient food and water and not even sufficient space to sleep.

(vi) PW signs were placed in most camps but were removed on orders from SAIGON.

(b) Against Indian PW

Crimes as in 3 (a) in addition to which threats, starvation and torture were used by the Japanese to persuade Indians to renounce their allegiance. All were starved and beaten, some were beaten to death yet nearly all remained loyal to their oath of allegiance.

(c) Against internees (male)

Crimes as against PW, but generally speaking internees were better treated.

(d) Against women and children

- (i) At LONGNAWAN. There are no survivors of this massacre. Native evidence indicates violation and mutilation of the white women before they were killed.
- (ii) At KUCHING. Treatment of the women and children was reasonable and Lt Col SUGA, CO PW Internment Unit IJA was responsible, although he seems to have been responsible for the ill treatment of male PW.

(e) Against the civil population

- (i) Javanese. Approximately 5,000 were imported, males as labourers, and some girls for brothels. They were overworked and starved to death. The few hundred recovered by Australian forces were in a pitiful state. Some statements have been made by the victims but they cannot name the Japanese responsible. Japanese HQ is preparing a list of all officers and units concerned. It is assumed that this matter will be handled by Dutch authorities.
- (ii) Chinese and Malays. The local community suffered severely at the hands of the Kempei Tai. Apprehended on suspicion only, they were interrogated under torture until they either died or admitted offences for which they were then summarily executed. Few were released after apprehension. Looting and pillage were common.
- (iii) Native women and children were tortured and executed. Indirect evidence has been found of cases of the raping of native women, but no actual cases have been brought forward.

(f) Crimes of policy

- (i) Inflation by the introduction of comparatively worthless Japanese invasion currency.

(ii) Economic paralysis by :-

confiscation of food and goods

neglect of plantations and other native employments

lack of maintenance of general utilities.

Apparently the Japanese did NOT plan for permanent occupation.

(iii) Prestige

Every opportunity was taken to increase the prestige of the Japanese by subjecting British, Australians and Americans to public ridicule and humiliation.

This policy failed signally and the civil population remained almost completely loyal.

4. A summary of the results of investigations here is as follows:-

- (a) A total of 898 Japanese were listed as suspects.
Of these -
 - (i) 444 are in custody and either have been tried or are awaiting trial.
 - (ii) 36 are known or reasonably believed to have died.
 - (iii) 16 are wanted to answer substantial charges but are known to have left ~~BRITISH~~ BORNEO prior to surrender. Further search outside ~~BRITISH~~ BORNEO is warranted.
 - (iv) 33 are wanted to answer substantial charges but cannot be traced or identified. The whereabouts of these is unknown, but if the names are correct they are not as far as can be ascertained, in internment in ~~BRITISH~~ BORNEO.
 - (v) 238 were either released to simple internment after interrogation and investigation, there being no substantial evidence against them. (These are held on PAPEW ISLAND), or not arrested as investigations disclosed no charge against them (these are in the various internment camps).
 - (vi) 131 have not been traced, in most cases because the names are wrong, or there being no substantial evidence against them, it was not considered that further search was warranted. Some were wanted for interrogation only.

- 5. (a) It was not practicable to prepare a separate file for each Japanese charged. A comprehensive card index system was therefore instituted. As each item of information was received it was filed consecutively and an appropriate reference noted on the card of each individual Japanese referred to. Before trial of any case it is only necessary to extract or copy from each file such evidence as relates to that particular case. Each card gives a brief summary of all information known including charges and witnesses with references to the appropriate files.
- (b) An index of material witnesses was also kept. Their evidence was obtained in the form of sworn statements where possible, but as it was considered that it might be desirable to call them, their full names and addresses were recorded.
- (c) Difficulties encountered were due to:-
 - (i) Reference to Japanese by nicknames only. The nicknames varied from compound to compound even when adjacent.
 - (ii) References by name were phonetic and then generally gave the surname only.

- (iii) The differing Japanese and Chinese rendition of the same characters results in many Japanese and all Formosans having two names.
- (iv) In some cases the names given were not in any way recognisable as Japanese names.

The use of a card index system facilitated the necessary comparisons and eliminations.

- (d) A nominal roll of Japanese in the order in which they were imprisoned at LAJUAN with photographs attached has been compiled. From this, a roll of all now required to answer charges, and showing AWC numbers in addition to local numbers, has been compiled and is forwarded to HQ AMF herewith, in compliance with paragraph 7 of HQ AMF 151625. Negatives are forwarded under separate cover.

6. Card indices and relevant files, except as noted elsewhere in this report, are held here to be handed over to the British authorities on their arrival. As trials are proceeding in all cases in which Australian personnel were the victims, the cards and files which relate only to such cases will not be included.

7. Appendix A sets out a collected summary of all "incidents" reported and the results of investigations in each case. It is believed that it includes every major war crime committed during the Japanese occupation in the area covered.

8. Appendix B is a complete list of Japanese whose names have been linked with war crimes. It indicates charges laid and final results of investigations. AWC numbers are shown in the last column. This list is divided into two parts:-

- (a) Japanese wanted in connection with cases in Category B, i.e., in which Australians were amongst the victims.
- (b) Japanese wanted in connection with cases in Category C, i.e., in which no Australians were involved.

(There were no cases in this area falling in Category A). Each part is divided into sections corresponding with the groups set out in paragraph 4 above. The particulars in Appendix B comply as fully as possible with the requirements of paragraphs 8, 16 and 17 of HQ AMF 151625. It is unlikely that there will be any additions or alterations to this list; if there are, details will be forwarded to HQ AMF in accordance with the memo referred.

9. All Kempei Tai personnel found in ~~SOUTH~~ NORTH BORNEO are included in Appendix B. Those in section (c) of each part of Appendix B against whom no charges have been laid, are held on PAPEN ISLAND.

10. It cannot be too strongly recommended that trials of Japanese charged with offences against civilians be held in the centres where such offences were committed:-

- (a) For the impression which will be created amongst the local population.
- (b) Because the witnesses are numerous and their written evidence, even if admissible under section 9 of the War Crimes Act, is often unsatisfactory both in form and matter.
- (c) Considerably more evidence is available than is recorded in our files.

Two petitions from residents of MIRI have been received requesting that trials and punishments be carried out in that area.

11. It is recommended that trials of high ranking officers be left to the last so that any further evidence of their responsibility, brought out in the previous trials, may be used to strengthen the case against them.

12. (a) It is desired to place on record that the following Formosan guards behaved very well towards PW, assisted them in many ways and in some cases were punished for so doing:-

(b) HASEGAWA, Herbert K, born of Japanese parents in HAWAII, is held in the No 1 Surrender Compound. He is technically a US subject, and seems to be strongly anti-Japanese, which has been demonstrated by his great assistance in investigations. He first went to JAPAN in 1939 with his parents, and to avoid being called up for the Army, joined the propaganda branch as an interpreter.

(c) It is suggested that priority in repatriation be given to the abovenamed. HASEGAWA wishes to find his parents but not to remain in JAPAN.

APPENDIX "A"

Part I.

War Crimes against Australians and Allied Nationals
(category "B").

1. Prisoner of War and Internment Camps.

All PW and I Camps in BORNEO were under command of Lt-Col SUGA who has since committed suicide. They were manned by a staff of Japanese HQ's and Formosan guards of whom all surviving members are believed to have been arrested. In all camps medical supplies were almost unobtainable, food was reduced (about the end of 1944) to a level insufficient to sustain life, and physical ill-treatment was a regular practice.

A. KUCULIN

The condition of inmates on release varied greatly. The British OR's were by far the worst and half of them had already died. They were starved and at the same time forced to do heavy work, and had not the money to buy extra food. The Indians, although treated even worse, stood up to it better. The inmates of the other compounds worked less and were able to buy food secretly from the natives.

The Staff and guards were all arrested, and interrogated by an officer of this HQ with two former PW, Major McARTHUR and Lt SUNDERS. As a result those accused of gross ill-treatment (about 50) were held for trial and the remainder interned. Trials are now proceeding.

B. LABUAN

Nothing is known of actual conditions on the island, as there are no survivors, but of 300 PW, 158 died. The remainder were taken by the guards under Sgt SUINO via BRUNAI to MIRI, and the 46 still alive there were massacred. SUINO and all the guards involved have been tried and sentenced to death (subject to confirmation). The CO of the LABUAN Camp was Capt MAJAI (in custody) from its inception till early this year, then Sgt SHYU who is held for other offences, and then SUINO. No direct evidence is held against MAJAI.

C. JESSELTON

This camp was opened late in 1942 under Capt HAKETA (on trial for KUCULIN offences) and from the health aspect seems to have been indescribably bad. For this reason, survivors were moved by Capt MAJAI to SANDAKAN where at the time conditions were quite fair. Little is known of this camp as few survivors have been traced and most probably died at SANDAKAN. All known members of the staff are held on other charges.

D. SANDAKAN

Capt HOSHIJIMA (in custody) was in charge from just after the inception till May 1945. Capt TAMARU (in custody) took over for a few weeks and was followed by Lt MORITANI, who died about July 1945, and then Sgt MOROZUMI (in custody) till the last PW died in Aug 45. Other Officers were present from time to time including Capt MAJAI against whom there is little evidence of ill-treatment and Lt WATKINS. Apart from physical brutality conditions were reasonable till late 1944 when the ration was cut progressively, and 1400 men died of sickness and starvation.

Capt HOSHIJIMA will be tried, and most of the guards are held on charges of murder committed either at SANDAKAN, on the SANDAKAN-RANAU marches, or at RANAU. Of the remainder some were reported by WO I STICHELWICH, a survivor of the camp, to have been reasonable. The remainder will be tried on charges of ill-treatment. After the marching parties were taken to RANAU, over 100 sick men were left in the camp. Some weeks later 23 of the fit men were taken to the airstrip and shot. The remainder, too sick to move, were abandoned to starve to death. Lt MORITAKI, Sgt NOROZUMI and the guards were responsible and except for MORITAKI (dead) are held for trial.

E. RANAU

The survivors of the first march found no provision whatever made for them at RANAU. Food was almost unobtainable and medical supplies were non-existent; they were employed carrying rice from PAGINAPAI to RANAU; many died of sickness and starvation and a number were killed by the guards at the orders of SUZUKI (not the one mentioned above). This officer was later killed by a Formosan guard. The guards responsible for the massacre are in custody. NAGAI was at first in charge under the direct orders of Major WATANABE (in custody) the Area Commander. On his departure in May 1945 i.e. NAGAI SUZUKI took over till the arrival of TAKAKUWA.

The survivors of the second march found only six remaining of the first party. They found the same conditions but managed to build themselves a hut. Early in Aug 45 the 30 odd still alive were killed in three groups. Of the Officers, NCO's and guards responsible all now known to be alive are in custody.

2. SANDAKAN-RANAU MARCHES

A.

The first march started late in Jan 45. It was under command of Capt YAMAMOTO (in custody) and policed mainly by No 1 Coy of the 20 Ind MG Bn under Capt ABE. The prisoners were divided into nine groups of approx 50, separately guarded about 1 day's march apart, and each under an officer nearly all of whom are held. There were also some Formosan guards of SUGA's unit, most of whom are held. This case is still under investigation but it seems clear that all stragglers who did not die of exhaustion or sickness were shot.

B.

The second march under Capt TAKAKUWA started late in May 45. Most of the fit men had already left and many sick were forced to go at the point of the bayonet. About 550 PW were included, divided into 3 main groups and subdivided into 50's. The only officers known to have been involved are TAKAKUWA, Lt WATANABE (in custody) and Lt SUZUKI (in custody). Sub-groups were under NCO's a number of whom are held. The guards were - (a) Formosans of SUGA's unit under WATANABE of whom most are held (b) members of several other units of whom a few are held.

C.

The third march, under Lt IWASHITA, included 75 sick PW. None reached RANAU, and the last surviving Japanese who was on this march (Pte ICHIKAWA) died at JESSELTON on 8 Dec 45 before being fully interrogated.

5. JESSELTON

Three captured American airmen were tortured and hung in Sep 44. The perpetrators are in custody - MUKAI (399) NUKUSHINA (420) and TSUJI (382).

6. SARAWAK

Two captured American airmen were executed 8 Jun 45. Three of the four Japanese responsible are in custody - TAKAGAWA (401) HAYASHI (422) FURUKAWA (443).

7. LAHAD DATU.

After the original landing European residents were on several occasions severely beaten and humiliated and then property looted. Lt AOYAGI (left BORNEO for GUADALCAGAZA) was originally responsible with KIMURA (38 - in custody) and KUSIMOTI (believed dead). Capt KAMATA (111 - in custody, relieved AOYAGI and with the abovenamed and HIRAKATSU (108 - in custody) continued the same practices.

8. KUALA BELAIT.

A group of Indian PW was held here under Capt KAMIMURA (319 - in custody). Originally some of them were at SARIA under Lt IIDA (55 - in custody). Lt YAMAGUCHI (317 - in custody) was apparently mainly responsible for them. They were starved, beaten and deprived of medical supplies in the usual way. Of the guards responsible the following have been identified with reasonable certainty viz IGUCHI (324), NAKAMATA (624), NOMATA (331), TERASAKA (333 - Lt i/c rationing), KOYAMA (310), OKA (334), SHIRASAKA (311), KOBAYASHI (315) and MORIZONO (330). However better evidence will have to be obtained from the Indians who named them. All the above are in custody.

On 10 Jun 45 the 70 still surviving were massacred. A few escaped with wounds and have named - Lt YAMAGUCHI (317), YAMASHITA (309), NORIYAMA (623), OHO (312), SHIRASAKA (311), SONODA (320), SUMIYOSHI, (318), TERASAKA (333) and IKUMA (714) as being present. Some of these have admitted being present and YAMAGUCHI states he was acting on the orders of KAMIMURA, who in turn pleads the orders of FUJINO (323). All the above are in custody but better evidence will be necessary to secure convictions.

9. LUTONG

(a) A group of Indians PW (it is not clear whether they had joined the Japanese or not) was held here under Capt AZUI (364) and Lt NAGAO (627) and other officers. Of the guards named by the Indians as responsible for ill-treatment and beatings the following are in custody - FURUICHI (373), IKUMATA (74), IKUMA (376), KONO (66), MINORI (374), NAGAO (97), OANDA (365), SAITO (75), FUKUDA (618), KANDA (616), KUYUMAGI (617). Identifications are not satisfactory in some cases and better evidence from the Indians is required.

(b) Five Indians were killed on 18 Jun 45. Maj IKEGAMI (104) ordered it, and Sgt KAWAYOSE (251), UMEMA (252) and IWASE (108) carried it out. All are in custody.

(c) Eleven Indians were killed on 27 Jun 45. The same officer ordered it, and the following were involved: TAKAHASHI (82), TAKAHASHI (68), TAKAHASHI (44), MIYOSHI (63), HISANO (64).

(d) LACHMAN SINGH was beaten to death by Lt SHIMIZAWA (67) and SAITO (75). Lt HATASHITA (188) issued a false death certificate.

NOTE : Reports were received from BRD sources that in Jun - Jul 45 parties of 140, 80, and 60 PW were marched along the track through ULU SAPI under escort, and that the escort returned without them. The officers were named. On checking the story with the ORANG TUA of MUMBAD near ULU SAPI, it appears that the parties were the three main groups of the second march, the officers named were merely in charge of maintenance of the track, and patrolled it in the course of their duties. The ORANG TUA also stated that 53 PW were killed at MUMBAD on 27 Jul. This appears to relate to the third march. The killing was done by unidentified Kempei Tai.

u. USBO incident.

- A. The death of Fl/Lt GILBERT at TAWAO was the subject of exhaustive inquiries. There is no evidence of any war crime.
- B. Capt MATTHEWS and others were arrested at SANDAKAN Camp on charges of having a wireless set, organising for escapes and preparing a revolt. There seems to have been some truth in these charges. They were interrogated by Kempei Tai NOO's, KONO and MOTOKI (both in custody) with the usual accompanying torture, sent to KUCHING and given a so-called trial. MATTHEWS was executed and the others imprisoned.
- C. A Kempei Tai NOO, HOSOTANI, is held for the killing of stragglers on the SANDAKAN-RANAU march.

PART II.

Crimes against allied nationals (Category "C").

1. Employment of PW on improper labour.

- (a) Col OTSUKA (570) Area Commandant SANDAKAN is held on a charge of permitting PW to be employed on airstrip construction and bomb disposal at SANDAKAN. The ultimate responsibility is Lt-Gen YAMAMAKI's (BABA's predecessor). OTSUKA could be tried under category (A) but his more serious offences were against the native population.
- (b) Capt MIURA (230) is held as CO of the unit which supervised PW working on KUCHING Airstrip.
- (c) Major FURUICHI (335) is held on the same charge.
- (d) Major KITAO (350) is held on a similar charge. His unit employed PW handling bombs and petrol at LABUAN.

2. LONG MATAN Massacre } see main report
PONTIANAK Incidents }

The perpetrators were members of the original invasion forces most of which moved on very early, and are reported to have gone to GULUANG where they were annihilated.

3. KENINGAU

On 6 Jul 45 four Europeans and one Chinese were killed at KENINGAU. Lt-Col ABE (2), Major OKABAYASHI (307), Lt AKUTAGAWA (10), S/M KIUCHI (304) and Civilian KUMAGAI (41) were implicated and are all held in custody.

4. RAUSILANGAN.

Two captured American pilots were shot in Nov 44. The Japanese responsible (SAKAI403) is in custody.

- (e) An Indian was murdered by MANO (620).
 (f) Several Indians were severely beaten by Lt OKAMURA (46).

10. Ill-treatment of PW working at Airstrip Kuching.

The following (all in custody) were involved: Lt SAKATA (180), KAGEYAMA (187), UETAKA (141 - the "Gorilla"), and to a lesser degree ASADA (343), ISHIKAWA (348), JITSUHIRA (732), AKAZAWA (349), KIMURA (342), KIMURA (347), KOBAYASHI (233), KOBAYASHI (372), MURAKAMI (340), MURATA (301), NAGAO (346), NAKAZATO (338), OYAMA (379), SARATO (350), SASAKI (345), SETO (177), SUGIYAMA (231), TATENO (341), UEMOTO (375), YAMAZAKI (337), YONETANI (234), YOSHI (339), ORIBE (), KONNO (), OZAKA (344) and TAKAIYAMA (). Except as regards the first three the evidence is very unsubstantial. They all belong to FURUICHI or MIURA units (see para 1).

11. Ill-treatment of PW working at Shipyards, Kuching.

The following (all in custody) were involved; HOSOKAWA (228), KAWABATA (226), MATSUEDA (178), MIYATA (229), SUZUKI (83), MIYAKE (227), and UETAKA (141) (see above para 10). All are members of MIURA unit (see para 1). Except for UETAKA, the evidence is very weak.

12. Ill-treatment of PW working on Airstrip, Sandakan.

This work was originally supervised by HOSHIJIMA (6) Unit. When this unit was broken up, some of the worst were selected to remain as guards. As a result of the disbandment of the unit it has been impossible to trace many of those responsible and those traced have been not seriously implicated.

PART III.

Crimes against civilian natives.

These are too numerous to deal with in detail, and are grouped below according to areas. In most of the cases enough evidence is held to identify the perpetrators, but not enough to ensure conviction. The necessary evidence is readily available in the areas indicated. For the reasons given in para 10 of the main report trial in the place where the offence was committed is considered to be essential.

Most of the offences were committed by Kempei Tai personnel; some by Jap civil police; some by members of the civil administration; and a few by the military forces proper. In all cases reference to the relevant evidence is noted in the index card of the individual accused.

Nearly all the offenders have been traced and are in custody on LABUAN. However Kempei Tai personnel were moved about to a considerable degree and some have undoubtedly left BORNEO. It is not considered that sufficiently reliable particulars are held to warrant a wider search for them.

Cases occur of joint offences by several individuals, but such individuals will usually be found to be implicated in other joint or separate offences. Separate trials will therefore probably be unavoidable.

1. LAHAD DATU.

(a) Kempei Tai activities resulted in many deaths. See evidence of HIRAMATSU (file 429).

(b) Oppression and ill-treatment of natives by the Japanese Council of Small Holders. Of the individuals named the following are in custody :- ASO (605), KIMURA (38), OTZUKI (588), KUNITAKI (603), KANNO (607),

TAKEDA (Female, held in compound at JESSBLTON), Dr SAIBATA (Medical Officer on PAPUA Is) and NAGAKAMI (604). See file 144 and evidence referred to on index cards. HIRIKATSU (608) is also involved.

2. SANDAKAN.

- (a) Kempei Tai activities throughout the Japanese occupation were attended by the usual torturings and executions. See especially the evidence of S/maj IKOH and P.C. LUNGGIS (file 427). The civil police were equally bad.
- (b) At one stage a "purge" was instituted and all English speaking natives and Chinese were arrested. Many were executed. The orders appear to have originated from Col OTSUKA.
- (c) After PT boats entered SANDAKAN Harbour a party of marines of AIDA unit came ashore and alleging that the Chinese were assisting the Allies, entered a number of houses and bayoneted men, women and children. This case is not yet fully investigated but the following are held on suspicion: Capt KITADA (110), Lt OKUSE (113), Lt UTSUMI (572), Pte AKIYAMA (120), Pte KITAZATO (131), Pte KIMURA (128). The case depends on personal identification and it will be necessary to take witnesses from SANDAKAN to JESSBLTON to identify personnel of AIDA unit. Capt AIDA (631) admits giving orders to his unit to "arrest" civilians.
- (d) Capt KUKITA (not yet traced) was in charge of a detachment of Marines operating what are described as "amphibious tanks". They were apparently a secret, and he had four natives shot for seeing them.
- (e) The civil administration was responsible for commandeering food essential to the natives early in 1945. KUMABE (600) as Governor is principally responsible.

3. TAWAO.

A number of Chinese were charged with assisting guerillas by raising funds. After the usual investigations of the Kempei Tai there was a so-called trial. Seven were executed and the remainder imprisoned. Those who carried out the sentence of the Court were arrested but released to simple internment as the carrying out of a duly pronounced sentence does not appear to be a war crime. The Kempei Tai personnel who carried out the investigations are however held and are mostly also wanted for offences at SANDAKAN.

4. JESSBLTON.

Apart from the usual Kempei Tai offences the "api incident" is to be noted.

A number of Chinese initiated a rebellion about Oct 44. This was put down. Reprisals were then taken and in the ensuing investigations several hundred Chinese and natives were killed. The inhabitants of SULU Island were massacred man, woman and child. This was mainly the work of the Kempei Tai. Some hundred Chinese were apparently "tried" before execution. The senior surviving member of the court is Lt-Col SAGO (81), whose unit also took part in the hunt for victims. He is in custody. The civil governor of the area, KUJI (40) is also in custody.

5. BRUNEI.

The main incident reported is the killing of 10 Chinese

including one WONG. Some of those accused were found at JESSALTON, namely NAGABUCHI (302) SAKAI (333) and TSUJI (332). See file 107.

6. KUALA BELAIT

Killing of a chinese and two Indians about 10 Jun 45. IKUMA (314) and SAKAI (believed dead) were responsible.

7. MIRI-LUTONG.

(a) massacre of 28 chinese hostages at LUTONG Bridge on 13 Jun 45. Capt KASAI (285) ordered it and CHIKASAWA (288) HARADA (292) MAEDA (286) KATO (290) KO JIMA (298) KORI (297) MARUGAME (48) MORISAKI (294) SAHARA (287) and TAKANO (270) carried it out.

(b) massacre of 10 chinese at the same place on 17 Jun 45. This was ordered by Maj IREGAMI (104) and carried out by YAJIMA (105), HAGAOTO (239), KIUCHI (107), FUJIHARA (106) and MAEDA (248).

8. SIBU.

Beating and torturing of Chinese. See file 428.

9. KUCHING.

Numerous statements in the files attest to torturing and beating of civilians in this area.

10. SENGGAU.

After the Japanese landing at ^{Kuching} ~~SENGGAU~~ many Indians and Indonesians who had been captured were massacred at SENGGAU. The unit responsible is believed to have left BORNEO for NW GUINEA, where, according to Japanese information, it was annihilated.

PART IV.

Charges against senior commanders.

1. Lt-Gen BABA - at present held in No 1 Surrender Compound. Evidence is awaited from SACSEA as to his early activities as he was Commander of the 5th Jap Division in MALAYA and SUMATRA. He assumed command in BORNEO about the beginning of 1945, and by March communications throughout NORTH BORNEO were difficult. After the Australian landing they were non-existent. It is considered that he is, however, responsible for -

(a) Neglect of the PW problem. Most of the deaths occurred during his regime.

(b) Ordering the SANDAKAN-RANAU marches

(c) Permitting or authorising the "purgings" in SANDAKAN and TAWAO.

2. Lt-Gen YAMAMOTO - not located, listed also by United Nations War Crimes Commission. It is considered that he is responsible for -

(a) Ordering the reduction in PW rations towards the end of 1944.

- (b) attempting to force Indians to join the Imperial Japanese Army.
- (c) permitting inflation of the currency
- (d) general policy of extortion and oppression towards the native population.
- (e) treatment of Javanese labourers
- (f) authorising the JASSALTON reprisals.

3. Maj-Gen MANAKI - last reported in INDO-CHINA. This man personally set the example in KUCHING, of beating PW. He gave addresses laying down as a policy that the BRITISH were to be treated as a fourth-rate nation and were to get fourth-rate food. He is also believed to have been implicated in the reduction of PW rations.

4. Col HACHIGUCHI - held in No 1 Surrender Compound. Chief of the Kempei Tai and as such considered responsible for their innumerable crimes.

5. KUJI, KAMABU (Prison Compound) Governor of the West Coast province from Oct 44. He took over just after the "Api incident" and was there throughout the reprisals. The division of responsibility between him and YAMAKI is not clear. He was, however, present at over 100 executions.

6. KUMBE (Prison Compound) Governor of East Coast Province. He is considered responsible for -

- (a) the activities of the civil police in SANDAKAN
- (b) the confiscation of crops.

7. Col OTSUKA (Prison Compound) Military Commander SANDAKAN Area. He is considered responsible for -

- (a) improper use of PW labour
- (b) ordering "purge" of suspected allied sympathisers.

and is also believed to be implicated in the ordering of the SANDAKAN-RANAU marches. It also appears that he withheld medical supplies from the PW camp. The exact amount of responsibility he had for the camp is not clear.

All the above cases depend on evidence to be brought forward in minor cases, and in the course of these further evidence will probably come out. Trials of the above should therefore be deferred till all other cases are disposed of.
