

Camp Baker is 375 acres of heavily wooded land leased from the Army Corps of Engineers. Located on the northeast side of the juncture of the Albemarle

Chesapeake Canal and Centerville Chesapeake, Turnpike, in Virginia, Camp Baker is open for short-term camping. Many scouting activities such hiking, pioneering, camping, wilderness survival, nature, and bird study can be conducted here. Thanks to the Associated General Contractors, the camp includes an activity shelter and latrines. Campers will need to supply their own water. It's a great place to

Directions: From I-64, Exit 286B: Travel 0.6 miles on Indian River Road, turn right on Centerville Turnpike and continue 5.8 miles,

before crossing Intercostals Canal bridge turn left. From Moyock, NC: Take Route 168 Bus to S Battlefield Blvd go 1 mile, continue on Centerville Turnpike S 6.6 miles. From the intersection of Mount Pleasant Rd and Centerville Tpke: Travel north on Centerville Tpke S go 0.7 miles, turn right immediately after crossing bridge. •From Kempsville

and Butts Station Rd: Turn S at Butts Station Rd go 2.1 miles, turn right at Centerville Tpke N go 0.6 miles, turn left before crossing bridge.
