Harmon sold land to Michael Wallis in 1716. He had to be 18 to sell land, and I used this date to approximate a birth date for Harmon.

Other Reads in Pt Geo, VA at the same time as Harmon & Ann were: Mary, Wm. & Thos.

In Pt. Geo in 1738, Wm. Reed & wife Martha ack. deed of land to Jas Heath.

In VA., Abraham, Jos. & Mary Reed had land patents.

Record of Harmon in Isle Wight from 1730 to 1749. Record of Harmon in Edgecombe, NC between 5/19/1748 & 5/16/1749.

In Isle Wight the same time as Harmon: Ann; Eliz; Harman; John; Samuel & Wm.

Harmon's will: WB#1, p. 27, will #135 in Halifax, NC courthouse.

MPendry: WB 3, p. 15-16, Will #271. Mary Pendry c/b part of the Henry Pendry family of Isle of Wight, VA. LDS Film #32004, Isle of Wight Deeds 1745/6, p. 475, 22 Oct. 1744. Aaron Pendry, Planter sold 100 A. (N. side of Meherin River) on line of John Windom (one of Harmon & Ann's dau. married a John Windom) & Harmon Read. This could be Mary's brother or father. I don't think this is her son...don't believe he would be old enough to own land.

VA Land Patent Bk #15, p. 163, 28 Feb. 1733, Richard Bland and Edward Lundy bought land on N. side of Maherin River on John Pendry and Harmon Read's line.
