Tornado hit in this area that P.M.

Jan 21st Made schools in  
East Darrin - after leaving  
last school ran into heavy  
rain until I reached Pauls  
Valley - Miss Florence Remine  
my hostess, and I enjoyed  
getting supper together  
then watched the final  
wind up of the indignation  
scenes on T.V.

Jan 22nd

Bought gas at Texaco &  
found I had left my bill  
fold at Miss Remine's home  
She, fortunately, had not yet  
gone to her school, so O.K. go  
me with the Texaco man by  
phone, then I returned to pick  
up my billfold, pay for the  
gas, and arrived at Rocky  
School, 20 miles away by 8:40  
A.M. The neph school Woodland  
Consolidated brought their  
150 students in to see the  
filmy strip on the Sabernacle  
just before the 4-H Club took  
over at Hennepin School

after a good hot lunch  
I showed the story and  
checked the children  
for their gospels & gave  
away 3 Testaments.

At Tatum's (consolidated <sup>negro</sup> school) 109 saw the film  
and the high school students  
were checked out girl receiving  
her Bible. Here I forgot to check  
the 4th grade.

Jan 23<sup>rd</sup> After showing  
Mr. Seaton Supt of Elmwood  
schools, I hurried over to  
show film to 75- Junior High  
students & check for Bibles.  
At Bryant <sup>small</sup> negro school I  
gave Supers to the teacher  
to give to his wife who teaches  
at Tatum's for the 4th grade  
that I had forgotten to check  
the day before. At Pernell's  
large school the Supt.  
invited me out to eat  
lunch with him, and he  
said he would like to see  
The tabernacle only had



a class to teach the next hour. He had me show the Christmas film in his classroom a month ago. Seems like folks want to know more about the Bible these days. The last school was Winterton (negro) when I finished the film, and was checking the children, the teacher said "This work you do sure does give one a lift." This evening Margie Speaks had a nice hot supper again in Elmore City, and we went to choir practice together. On our way home my ankle, which

at choir-practice, the leader (also  
high school coach) read Prov 23  
was struck by verse 8. He prescripted  
I had sprained to-day right  
to hurt. Margie fixed it  
up with hot water and Ben  
Gay. But is it giving me  
fit? Guess I'll take an  
Anacin.

Jan 24<sup>th</sup> Roy, Margie's husband  
offered to help me down to the  
locker where we eat,  
but I told him I'd get in  
the car and drive down to  
the side door. After a good  
breakfast of home made corn  
cage, and hot cakes & coffee  
I took off for the Party school.  
The <sup>teacher</sup> there said they  
had built a new house, and  
asked us to stay all night.

With them next thing we  
came - She and her husband  
are so cooperative. How the  
Lord does "clear the way before  
you"! I hurried on to Parks &  
Antioch (taking lunch here at  
11:30) and arrived in Mayville  
at 12 o'clock bought gas &  
drove on toward Hughes,  
(another large consolidated) How!  
I had a flat!! Pulled off on the <sup>shoulder</sup>  
Just then two men drove up in  
two cars. One offered to take me  
back 150 yds to a filling station -  
But the man there couldn't help  
me as his partner had gone  
to lunch. I stayed there and  
waited 40 min. and prayed. Then

the best thing of the whole week  
was a 12 yr. boy accepting Christ  
at the car as I gave him his Bible  
he had earned. I learned his partner had gone  
to a Kiwanis luncheon. Just  
then a truck driver came in  
and he went with me to the car  
changed the tire and wouldn't  
let me pay him anything. The  
Lord surely answered prayer by  
sending him along. And I did  
get the next two school kids  
before 3:30 when the parents  
came for their children.  
I am glad to be home again  
as sleet & snow are predicted  
for the week-end!

April 23rd

again I am in Garrison Co.  
(I got there I made it March 12th) and  
but she had to go home April 17th  
again bad weather. My 1st day



after visiting Satterwhite school  
I came over a hill, and saw a  
label? of water running over  
the highway. Driving down I  
looked it over & decided to back  
up the hill where a man said  
"Don't be afraid, lady, I just crossed  
it. It only comes up to your  
bumper. If you take it in low  
and drive slowly you'll make it"  
So I did. On reaching the next  
to the last school I hesitated but  
going off the highway to make it  
since there were ~~burned~~ holes,  
but went, and there found our  
long lost Laber made film strip  
and which we had often prayed  
to find. It had fallen into  
the hole <sup>(interrupted)</sup> for the ink bottle, of  
an old fashioned desk and a

little negro had found it days later. Here the lamp in my projector burned out but the negro lady teacher had one so we proceeded to use hers.

However at McCarty there was no projector so the flannel board was used. I said "I'll go to Paul's Valley to get another lamp." Mrs. Ellis said if I'd wait she would go with me. So after school she took me in her car and I bought the lamp with the only gas money I had with two days yet to go. But Mrs. Ellis said I want to pay for that lamp and gave me \$5.00. How good the Lord is! Praise our great Provider. <sup>April 24</sup> All last night it rained on our car and this a.m. <sup>it</sup> would not start.



Again the Lord nudged -  
Mrs. Ellis brought her vacuum  
cleaner to the school house,  
and attached it to our 50 ft  
cord, that reached to the car,  
and dried out the spark plugs!  
Praise His name! I made it to  
Elmore City on time. After the lesson  
3 boys helped take things to the  
car. One accepted Christ & gave  
himself to Him. All 3 went back  
rejoicing with their arms around  
each other. That P.M. while resting  
in Margie's locker, a boy of 12,  
who had heard the Easter lesson  
that A.M. also accepted Christ.  
At first he wanted to put it off  
but finally decided "I believe  
I'll do it now." So he did. Afterwards  
he said "I am glad I did that."

April 26-

The last day on arriving too early at Pinedale, two girls in 6th grade, who came on one of the 1st busses, decided for Christ and later, at the car, another boy. Before leaving home, I had prayed that some children would be saved on this trip. God really does answer prayer according to His Will!
