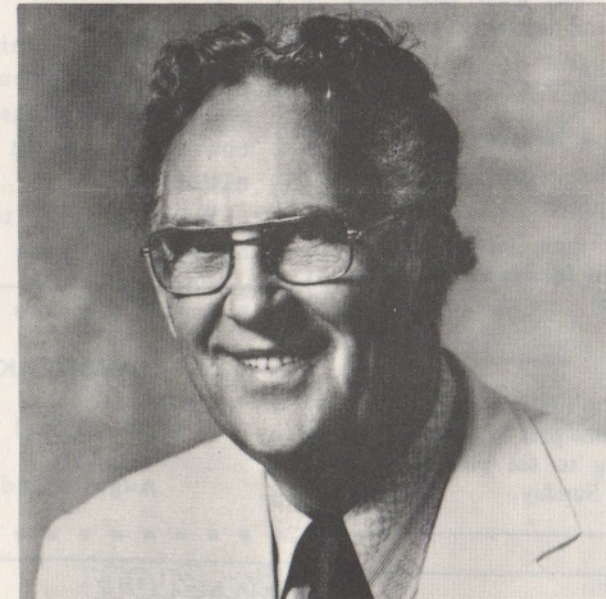

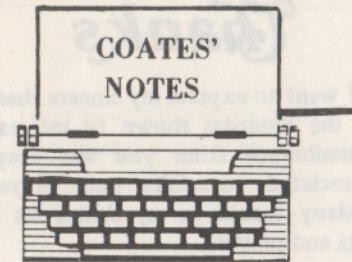

Dr. Daniels has written over twenty books, four of which are on marriage. He is also a marriage counselor.

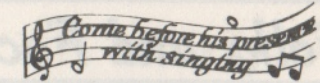
Dr. Daniels is a native of Florida. He was born and reared on a farm. And in his early ministry he used the slogan, "From plow handle to pulpit."
