 - b. A person is shown by His appearance on earth. Jesus being baptized with John, the spirit comes in a form of a dove. Some years later, Christ is gone and the spirit rushes into the upper room.

Here in the church we have a number of electric lights, there is absolutely no power in the electric bulbs nor in the wires, nor in the filaments, yet I can push the switch on the wall and the church is flooded with lights, that means that the advance of electric fixtures there is a great power, there is no power apart from me in the Holy Spirit.

Christians the Holy Spirit is a person, does he have an influence in your life.

The Holy Spirit is not a power for you to use, but a power to use you. How much of you does he have.

If the Holy Spirit calls you, you are not to go on in sin and rejects his call, if you heed his call you are treading on dangerous ground. I urge you to listen to him.
