

CHURCHES and RELIGION*Builders, Organizers***2 Brothers Active
As Area Ministers**

NORFOLK — Two of the most active ministers in the Tidewater area are brothers.

They are the Rev. Frank Hughes Jr., pastor of South Norfolk Baptist Church, and the Rev. J. Melvin Hughes, pastor of Princess Anne Plaza Baptist Church.

The Princess Anne Plaza pastor is serving a church that his brother Frank founded. He has specialized in building new churches, notably the Indian River and Brentwood churches in

1950 and 1957. He has been at Princess Anne Plaza for three years and is its first full-time pastor.

The South Norfolk pastor is a veteran of 19 years service at his church and has received 2,085 persons into the church during his pastorate. He has led in an increase of membership from 700 to 1,679 to make his church one of the largest in Tidewater Virginia.

The Hughes brothers are planning to organize other churches in the future.
