MATHEWS, VIRGINIA - Lena Virginia Hughes, 86, of Onemo,

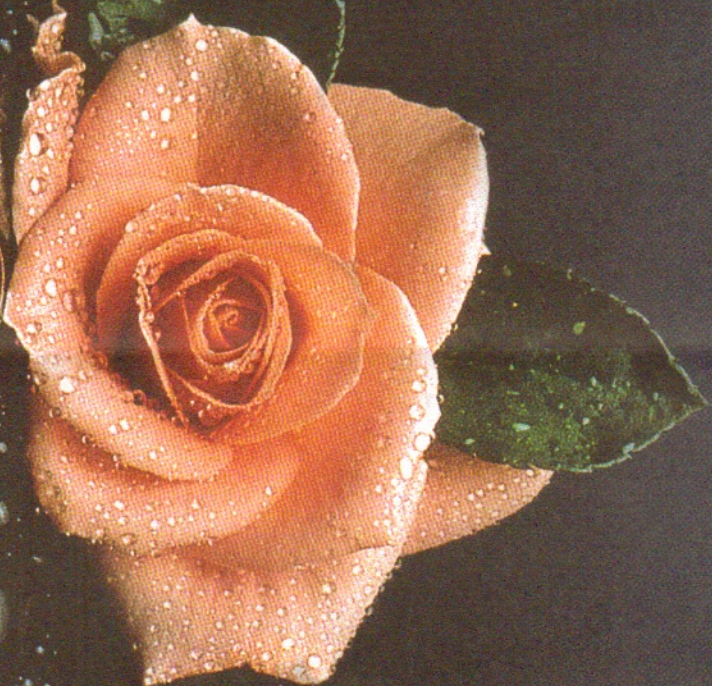
