

## MIDGET SUBMARINES

### SYDNEY HARBOUR EPISODE

SYDNEY, September 12.—A message from Tokio reveals that the midget submarines which entered Sydney Harbour in 1942 were brought pickaback by three large submarines. Each was attached to its mother ship, and automatically released. The two-man crews aboard were unable to free themselves, and none of them are expected to return. They stood off Sydney Heads for a long time waiting for a chance to follow some incoming ship through the boom defences. Finally they were sent in in the wake of a small ship entering the harbour.
