

VETERANS OF SIXTH DIVISION TELL OF JAPANESE CANNIBALISM

Enemy Ate Own Dead, Australian Prisoners or Natives

BRISBANE, Sept. 11.—Five hundred veteran members of the Sixth Division, including 13 Queenslanders, arrived in Brisbane this morning aboard the steamer River Fitzroy on their way home for discharge. The returned men received a warm welcome from thousands of people lining the city streets.
