

## Slayer of Eight Nazis Held in Mental Ward



UNDER OBSERVATION . . . Pvt. Clarence V. Berlucci (right), 23, of New Orleans, La., who yielded to the impulse he often expressed "to turn his guard tower machine gun on Germans at the Salina, Utah, war prison camp," today was under observation in a hospital mental ward at Fort Douglas, Utah. The .30-caliber weapon which pumped 250 bullets into tents in the area in which prisoners were sleeping, killed eight Germans and wounded 20 others.
