On Sec. Markwayne Mullins' Christian Nationalist Sect

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Markwayne Mullin is worse. As soon as he was appointed, those of us who understand White Christian Nationalism said he would be worse. He's a radicalized WCN extremist, a zealot member of City Elders, an NAR/Dominionist White Christian Nationalist sect based in Oklahoma.

As a Dominionist, he could be an apostle in that camp. Apostles tend to keep their identities hidden until they conquer their "mountain," part of the Seven Mountains Mandate. NAR apostles

speak in tongues and teach that God speaks through them. In other words, they claim to speak for God on earth.

His zealotry causes him to make radicalized extremist proclamations like *we're going to pull CBP from airports in sanctuary cities*. When he floats these ideas, he doesn't think about economics or logistics.

Protecting the gates from worldly influence (part of City Elders' mission) and forcing government to follow WCN beliefs are central to Markwayne Mullin. Once he achieves his mountain, he no longer needs to do simple political math.

City Elders describes itself as “a national network of elders charged with the mission of governing the gates of every city in America to establish the kingdom of God with strength, honor and courage.” Although not really a church, the group has IRS status as a church. There is no way to know exactly how much influence the group has or how many inroads it already has made because its “elders” are not typically identified.

The group, led by Pentecostal evangelist Jesse Leon Rodgers, sees its mission as biblical — drawing especially from Old Testament narratives of God's commands to Adam and Eve and God's commands to other kings and prophets of the Hebrew people.

These modern-day zealots take Old Testament passages as direct literal mandates for their intent to take over city councils, school boards, state government and even federal government. A video from 2023 shows Mullin speaking to the group and explaining his close and longstanding relationship with City Elders and Rodgers.
