## Rev. G. T. Waite, Baptist Leader, Dies in Richmond

RICHMOND, Va., May 16.—(P)—  
Rev. George Thomas Waite, D. D., general secretary of the Baptist Board of Missions and Education of Virginia, died yesterday at his home here after a five week's illness. He was 52 years old.

Dr. Waite was pastor of the Barton Heights church here for 12 years before assuming the post with the mission board. He served other pastorates at Herndon, Va., and Marion, Ala.

He was president of the Baptist Ministers' conference of Richmond in 1920-21. He was a member of the Baptist Council of Richmond and of the Baptist Foreign Board for several years.

Dr. Waite also was a member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Richmond, of the Phi Gamma Delta collegiate fraternity and the Masons.

He was born September 22, 1883, in Caroline county, the son of Henry W. and Virginia Faulkner Waite, both of Spotsylvania county.

Dr. Waite, twice married, is survived by his second wife, the former Miss Mildred Davis, of Herndon, one son, George Waite, Jr., a daughter Miss Elizabeth Waite; two brothers, W. P. and C. L. Waite, of Thornburg, and an aunt, Miss Fannie L. Faulkner, of Blanton.

Funeral services will be conducted from the First Baptist church here at 2:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. Burial will be in Forest Lawn cemetery.

IN VIRGINIA TODAY**

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**Baptist Missions Board General  
Secretary to Rest in  
Richmond.**

**RICHMOND, Va., May 16.**—Funeral services for Rev. Dr. George Thomas Waite, 52, general secretary of the Baptist Board of Missions and Education of Virginia, who died at his home here Friday, will be conducted at the First Baptist Church tomorrow at 2:30 p.m.

Interment will be in Forest Lawn Cemetery.

Dr. Waite, who served pastorates in Richmond and Herndon, Va., and Marion, Ala., before assuming the post with the mission board, was a former president of the Richmond Baptist Ministers' Conference. He served for a number of years as a member of the Baptist Council of Richmond and of the Baptist Foreign Missions Board, and also was a member of the board of trustees of the University of Richmond.

He attended the University of Richmond, graduating with the class of 1907, and graduated from the Southern Baptist Seminary at Louisville in 1911. He was ordained in 1909.

He was born September 22, 1883, in Caroline County, the son of Henry W. and Virginia Faulkner Waite, both of Spotsylvania County.

Surviving are his second wife, the former Miss Mildred Davis of Herndon; one son, George Waite, jr.; a daughter, Miss Elizabeth Waite; two brothers, W. P. and C. L. Waite of Thornburg, and an aunt, Miss Fannie L. Faulkner of Blanton.
